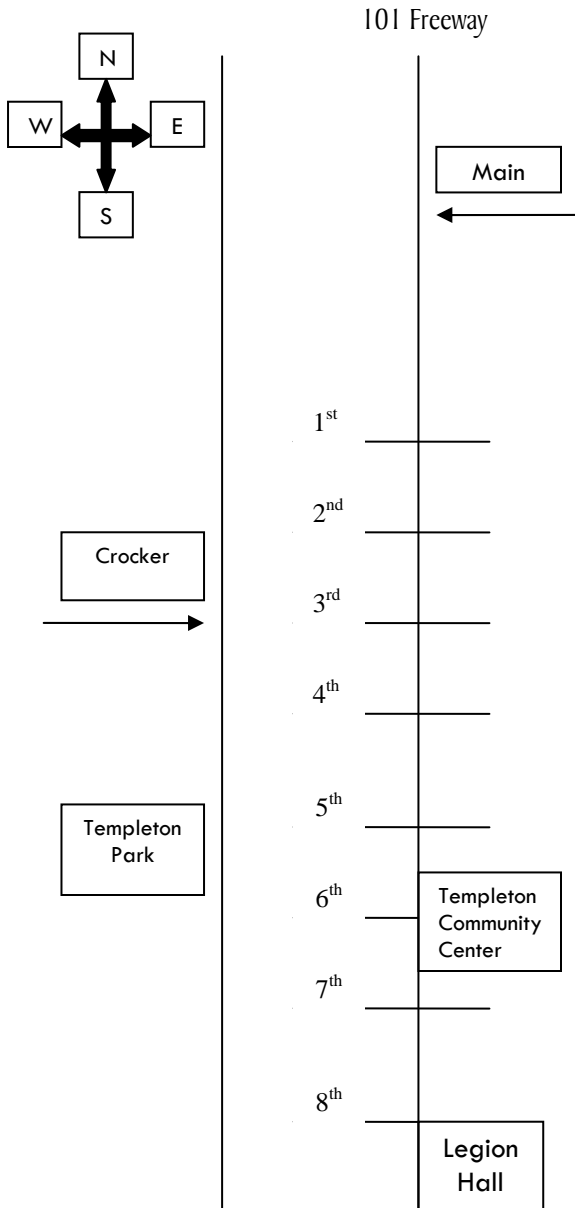


Map of Main Street Templeton

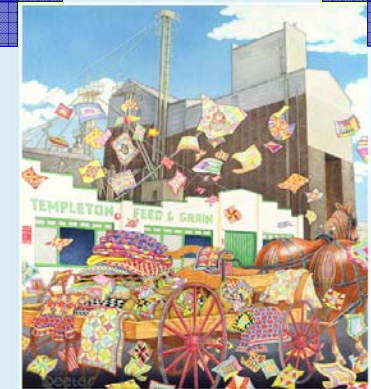

Outdoor Hanging Quilts can be found along Main Street from 8th Street to just north of 1st Street. See Map on back page. You might try walking 1/2 of this route, both sides of the street, then move your vehicle to lessen your walk to view the remaining quilts.

Amish Quilts from Pennsylvania, Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio can be seen hanging at the Templeton Community Center.

Opportunity Quilts, for raffle, are at the Legion Hall, the Community Center and along Main Street.

Quilts for Sale can be seen along Main Street. The paper attached to the quilt will show its sale price. To purchase, remove the Sales Tag from the quilt and ask the Volunteer at the Information Table in the American Legion Hall to assist you. For purchase of Amish Quilts, see Sue Geiger in the American Legion Hall.

Four Visitor’s Stations are set up for your convenience. The pop-up tented stations are at: 7th and Main, 509 S. Main, 309 S. Main, and 105 S. Main.

Bottled water, visors, and carry-bags can be purchased from the Chamber of Commerce at Curves—509 S. Main and at the Legion Hall.

White Glove Volunteers, identified by a Volunteer Badge, will be walking about on Main Street to assist you should you have questions.

Public Restrooms can be found:

- ⇒ 390 S. Main at The Templeton Market,
- ⇒ 601 S. Main at Templeton Community Ctr.
- ⇒ 8th and Main at Templeton Legion Hall
- ⇒ 6th & Crocker (one block west of Main) at Templeton Park.
